HOMILY OF JOHN PAUL II

Thursday, 13 November 2003

1. "I give them eternal life" (Jn 10: 28). Christ's words fill with light and hope our celebration today, during which we are praying for the Cardinals and Bishops who died in the course of the past year. The memory of the Cardinals who have left us was particularly present and vivid at the recent Consistory. I would also like to remember their names here: Hans Hermann Groër, Gerald Emmet Carter, Aurelio Sabattani, Francesco Colasuonno, Ignacio Antonio Velasco García, Corrado Ursi and Maurice Michael Otunga.
