

ADDRESS OF THE HOLY FATHER PAUL VI TO THE 11th LAMBETH CONFERENCE OF THE BISHOPS OF THE ANGLICAN COMMUNION

To His Grace

We have learnt with deep interest of the forthcoming eleventh Lambeth Conference of the Bishops of the Anglican Communion, to be held this year in the historic city of Canterbury.

Vivid memories of the Second Vatican Council enable us to appreciate the value of such a period of common reflection by Christian pastors, and we note with happiness that the theme which is to dominate the Conference is the place and function of the Bishop in the world of today.
